2. The First Monday Toy Auction is a public auction conducted at our auction venue. Bidders may participate at the auction venue or on the internet through Invaluable or AuctionZip, or they may leave absentee bids prior to the auction.
3. A buyer's premium of $13.5 \%$ applies to all successful bids. An online bidding fee of $5 \%$ applies to successful bids placed online with Invaluable or AuctionZip (total fee for online bidders 18.5\%). All fees include GST where applicable.
4. Bidding begins at each lot's advertised starting price and increases according to the following bidding increments:
