- 8. An absentee bid is the bidder's maximum bid, i.e. the highest amount that the bidder is prepared to pay. The winning bid on a lot may be less than the amount of the bid submitted, depending on the values of bids placed by other bidders.
- 9. At the "fall of the hammer", the highest bidder will be the buyer. If conflicting bids are received, they will be processed in the order in which they were placed, if this can be ascertained. If there is a dispute, the lot will be auctioned again or withdrawn at the Auctioneer's discretion. The Auctioneer's decision shall be final.
- 10. The starting price, which usually includes any reserve, will be shown in the catalogue. Items will normally sell for the starting price or above. If no bids are received at the starting price, the starting price may be lowered at the Auctioneer's discretion.
