Terms & Conditions for Auction Bidders

1. The “Hidden Treasures of Leuralla” auction shall be conducted on site at “Leuralla”, 36 Olympian Parade, Leura, NSW, in two sessions on Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th July 2023.
2. Bidders may participate in the auction directly with Trains, Planes & Automobiles, or online through Invaluable, or they may leave absentee bids prior to the auction.
3. A buyer's premium of 15% applies to all successful bids. An additional online bidding fee of 5% applies to successful bids placed online with Invaluable (total fee for online bidders 20%). All fees include GST where applicable.
4. Bidding begins at each lot's advertised starting price and increases according to the following bidding increments:

Bidders are requested to abide by the advertised bidding increments. If bids are received that do not conform to the increments, they shall be rounded up to the nearest increment.

5. Bids may be placed by:
 - (a) submitting an absentee bid by telephone, by email, through our website, or in person;
 - (b) registering as an internet bidder with Invaluable; or
 - (c) attending the auction and registering as a bidder.
6. All bidders must be registered before their bids shall be accepted. All bidders must supply their names and addresses. Proof of identity may be required.
7. By submitting a bid the bidder agrees to purchase the lot upon which the bid has been placed if the submitted bid is the winning bid.
8. When absentee bids are placed, it is the absentee bidder's responsibility to ensure that bids have been received and correctly recorded by the Auctioneer. If an email address has been supplied, a confirmation email of bids recorded shall be sent to the bidder prior to the auction. After the auction, successful bidders shall be notified, but we are not able to notify unsuccessful bidders. It is the absentee bidder's responsibility to find out whether bids have been successful.
9. An absentee bid is the bidder's maximum bid, i.e. the highest amount that the bidder is prepared to pay. The winning bid on a lot may be less than the amount of the bid submitted, depending on the values of bids placed by other bidders.
10. At the “fall of the hammer”, the highest bidder shall be the buyer. If conflicting bids are received, they shall be processed in the order in which they were placed, if this can be ascertained. The Auctioneer reserves the right to re-open a closed lot to allow for late or conflicting bids. If there is a dispute, the lot may be auctioned again or withdrawn at the Auctioneer's discretion. The Auctioneer's decision shall be final.
11. The published starting price usually includes any reserve. Items shall normally sell for the starting price or above. However, if no bids are received at the starting price, the starting price may be lowered at the Auctioneer's discretion.
12. Lots may be viewed prior to the auction at the Auction Venue “Leuralla” on Friday 14th July and during the auction sessions.
13. Lots are sold with all faults if any. Unless otherwise specified, items are sold untested with no warranty given to their mechanical or electrical operation. Electrically operated units are sold as collectables and come with no guarantee of working condition or safety; if the purchaser intends to connect such a unit to an electrical supply, the unit must first be tested by qualified personnel to ensure its safety and performance.
14. No error in the description shall void the sale or result in an adjustment of the price, unless theft or misadventure have occurred between viewing and sale.
15. The Auctioneer reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid.
16. Unsold lots may be available for sale for a short time after the auction, at the Auctioneer's discretion, and shall incur a buyer's premium of 20%.
17. Invoices may be issued during the auction sessions to successful bidders in attendance, otherwise invoices shall be sent to successful bidders on Monday 17th July. All purchases must be paid for by Wednesday 19th July.
18. Payment may be made by cash, credit card (MasterCard or Visa), EFTPOS, or bank transfer. A 1.5% fee applies to credit card payments. Bank fees or limits may apply to credit card or EFTPOS payments.
19. All lots purchased must be paid for prior to delivery. Title to the goods shall not pass to the purchaser until full payment for the goods has been received.
20. If a purchase remains unpaid after close of business on Wednesday 19th July, the sale shall be cancelled, the defaulting purchaser shall be barred from bidding in future auctions, and our online auction provider Invaluable shall be notified of the default.








