- All bidders must be registered before their bids shall be accepted. All bidders must supply their names and addresses. Proof of identity may be required.
- 6. By submitting a bid the bidder agrees to purchase the lot upon which the bid has been placed if the submitted bid is the winning bid.
- 7. When absentee bids are placed, it is the absentee bidder's responsibility to ensure that bids have been received and correctly recorded by the Auctioneer.
