Once again, we have a great variety of toys and collectables for you this month.

We start the auction with a selection of **diecast vehicles** including Matchbox 1-75's, Corgi, Dinky, and Australian Micro Models. The main attraction in diecast is the collection of military vehicles from **Dinky and Benbros**, which includes some rare and valuable models that we seldom see in such good condition.

On the military theme, we move on to some more of our **collection of figures** and sets from Britains, Conté, Collectors Showcase and King & Country. These are recently issued models, beautifully manufactured and detailed. They have been very popular in past auctions, so if you want some of them, get your bids in early!

Then it's time for trains, starting with a selection of **O-gauge**, including a few Australian locomotives, which always generate a lot of interest.

These are followed by a superb range of **Australian HO**, which is just the first instalment of a large collection we recently received. This collection includes steam and diesel

locomotives – many of them brass models – along with passenger and goods rolling stock. Most of these models have never been run and are like new. And there's a lot more to come, so you can look forward to seeing more Australian HO in the next few months.

We also have a good range of other HO/OO locomotives, rolling stock, track and accessories from Hornby, Tri-ang, and other leading brands.

The last part of the auction features a **huge range of aircraft**. There are many diecast planes, including some excellent models from Franklin Mint and Corgi, also plastic models and aircraft kits.

So we have plenty of trains, planes and automobiles this month, as well as many other interesting things.

The auction starts at 6:00pm next Monday, August 5th, at our Auction Rooms at The Gearin in Katoomba. All are welcome to attend. There is plenty of parking and refreshments are available.
