Our July auction is a little later than usual, but worth waiting for. We delayed the auction by one week because of the coronavirus lockdown in New South Wales, hoping the lockdown would end this weekend. Unfortunately, it has been extended, but our July auction will proceed nonetheless.

This auction has a lot to offer for our train enthusiasts. There's an excellent selection of O-gauge, including lots of Hornby, both pre-war and post-war. There is some Australian O-gauge, notably several lots of O Gauge House aluminium sides for NSW coaches, and we even have some of the original patterns that were used to mould these pieces.

There's plenty of HO/OO-gauge including some Australian models, and we have some superb prints of Australian locomotive paintings (we will see more of these in coming months). Track has been in short supply lately, so we're pleased to be able to offer quite a few bundles of HO/OO-gauge track in good condition.

A special highlight of this auction is the collection of Trix Twin, which includes locomotives, wagons, coaches, buildings, accessories and track.

We have had lots of cars in our recent auctions – and this one is no exception! We have a great range of Matchbox 1-75s and Yesteryears, also lots of other brands, including models in 1:18 and 1:24 scale. No Dinky or Corgi this time, they're having a little rest, but plenty of others.

This month also sees a good selection of Meccano including sets, boxes full of pieces, motors and magazines. There are also construction sets from Buz Builder, Ezy-Bilt, Brickplayer, and some less well-known brands.

We also have a range of books about cars, trains, and Meccano.

So many of us in Australia are in lockdown at the moment, and we hope our toys and collectables will help you pass the time enjoyably.

The auction starts at 6:00pm next Monday, July 12th. During lockdown, our Auction Rooms are not open to the public, so there will be no bidding from the floor. We will also accept telephone bids on lots starting at \$200 or more. If you are interested in telephone bidding, it is essential that you contact us before the auction to register as a telephone bidder.
