We have some lovely things on offer this month.

First up, an excellent selection of **1-gauge**, mostly from the collection of **Jim & Jennifer Walker**, who accumulated some remarkable garden railway models over the years. Many of these and are no longer available from the manufacturers, so you'll have trouble finding them elsewhere. They are all in good condition and quite a few have clearly never been run. It's a great opportunity for all the garden railway enthusiasts, and there is more of this collection to come in the next few months.

The 1-gauge selection includes several **live steam** locomotives, and we have a few other live steam items, including Mamod vehicles and stationary engines.

Also in trains, we have a large range of **Lionel O-gauge** for the American modellers, also a few from **Marx**. And if you look carefully, you'll see a couple of Standard Gauge items, too.

There's a nice group of **tinplate toys**, including Tri-ang, Minic, several Japanese brands, and Marx, notably our featured item, the **"Marx Merrymakers"**, which is complete and in working order. We don't see this one often and it is very collectable, as well as being a lot of fun.

Meccano makes a return this month, with a great variety of parts, motors, sets, and magazines. There's also a little Ezy-Bilt and Bayko, and some construction and engineering books.

We haven't forgotten the auto enthusiasts. We have a superb collection of **French Dinky** cars, trucks and buses; also a good range of the ever-popular **Micro Models**; some very nice **Matchbox Models of Yesteryear**; and large scale models including **Franklin Mint**.

So we hope there's something for everyone, a good mix of valuable collectables and fun things!

The auction starts at 6:00pm next Monday, August 5th, in our Auction Rooms at The Gearin in Katoomba. All are welcome to attend. There is plenty of parking and refreshments are available.
