First off, we have more **1-gauge** from the Jim and Jennifer Walker collection, including locomotives, wagons, coaches, buildings, figures and accessories. Of special note is our featured item, the **Accuraft 2-10-2**. As with most of this collection, these models have seen very little running and are in great condition.

We have a special treat this month for the **Australian HO** fans, with a very large selection of locomotives, particularly NSW diesels, and a good variety of rolling stock. It's a long time since we've had this much Australian HO, and it's in very good condition as well. There's also a range of American HO locomotives and rolling stock of lots of different types and brands.

In **N-gauge** we have locomotives including Kato, Minitrix, Arnold and Bachmann; also plenty of rolling stock, some track and accessories. Our special N-gauge item is Lot 323, the lovely display layout. Also check out Lot 383, which contains a very large number of locos and rolling stock, along with track, power and scenic items. This was recently a complete, operating N-gauge layout, and can be again!

There are also other bits and pieces, such as the Bemo locos and wagons, the Lone Star items, and some railway books and DVDs.

If you like trains (of course you do), you're bound to see something you need.

The auction starts at 6:00pm next Monday, September 2nd, in our Auction Rooms at The Gearin in Katoomba. All are welcome to attend. There is plenty of parking and refreshments are available.
