There's a great variety of toys & collectables in this month's auction. We have a huge collection of **military models**, including army vehicles in diecast and tinplate, guns of various kinds, a large range of diecast figures (some of them quite special), books about soldiers and toy soldiers, and various other items of military paraphernalia.

This month's auction also includes the **Tri-ang waterline ships** which we've previously mentioned. These are beautiful models, boxed and in excellent condition.

In diecast vehicles we have a sizable collection of **Micro Models** and **Spot On** (which are always much sought-after), a large selection of **Corgi**, some very good early **Matchbox**, and more fire engines.

The range of tinplate items includes several clockwork cars from **Schuco**, a manufacturer noted for its mechanical ingenuity. Some of these cars have working differentials; one even has an operating 5-speed gearshift. These are lovely models in good condition.

There is also a good selection of **O-gauge**, including some early **Bassett-Lowke** track, **Marklin** tinplate, a beautiful electric crane from **Bing**, and plenty of **Hornby** items, notably a rare "**Princess Elizabeth**" loco. Our featured item this month is the **Bing O-gauge tramcar**. This is a very early model (pre-WWI) and a beautiful example.

And that's just to name a few! There's a lot more, so use the links below to view the full list or download a catalogue. Viewing is open at our **Annandale** gallery next Saturday from 10:00am to 4:00pm, and at our **Mount Victoria** auction venue from 3:00pm on the auction day.
